

ZCT Sunday School Behaviour Expectations

Our Vision ZCT is to offer a nurturing and inclusive environment where all children experience God's love and begin their spiritual journey according to ZCT Sunday School Departments apostolic beliefs.

To make this vision a reality, ZCT Sunday School teaching staff, Support workers, students and parents/guardians will work together to build a positive and respectful environment.

ZCT is extremely grateful for the excellent and valued volunteers who give of their limited time to teach our children about the love of God.

ZCT Sunday School Department is thankful for the cooperation of parents/guardians in partnering with us and the Sunday School teachers to work toward our vision.

Behaviour Expectations

To make the classroom a beneficial learning environment for our children, ZCT and our volunteer Sunday School teachers expect certain behaviour from students. Sunday School teachers and students are expected to work toward a goal of mutual respect. The behaviour expectations for ZCT Sunday School pupils are:

- Be on time or early (Sunday School begins at 11:00)
- Be ready to have fun and learn about God (please bring your Bibles)
- Participate in classroom activities
- Follow the teacher's instructions
- Show respect to others in the classroom
- Keep phone out of sight unless otherwise instructed
- Keep hands to self
- Speak in turn and listen when others speak
- No food to be consumed in class room outside of designated snack times
- Take care of the classroom (use materials wisely and help clean up)
- Endeavour to complete set homework tasks continuing your spiritual journey at home

Corrective Action Plan

If a student does not meet the behaviour expectations, the teacher will inform the student that his/her behaviour does not meet expectations and will inform the student of the expected behaviour.

The student will be given an opportunity to correct their behaviour using a 1, 2, 3 method:

1 = Grace 2 = Warning 3 = Removal, from class activity.

Disruptive behaviour will be reported to and discussed with parents/guardians.

If a child's disruptive behaviour requires a child to be removed from a classroom or activity, parents must accompany the child for at least one session/class upon return. For example, parents will need to accompany the child to Sunday School for one Sunday.

If disruptive behaviour continues to be reported to parents, the Head of ZCT Sunday School will suggest a conversation with the Bishop. A mutually agreeable action plan will be created to promote and encourage appropriate behaviour for future classroom experiences.

ZCT Sunday School Department as ask that you support our policy and encourage your child to adhere to the guidelines put in place to support the development of our young people.

OUR BISHOP

I believe that children are our future'

So begins the lyrics to The Greatest Love of All, sung by the one and only George Benson. Well, by the help of the Lord our future at Zion City Tabernacle is looking great!

It's a privilege to be a part of this church, and our Sunday School is one of the greatest ministries that we have. It bodes well for our future, knowing that we are planting seeds that will blossom and flourish long after some of us are gone, unless Jesus comes back first.

Let's make no mistake though, the times that our children are being raised in are dangerous. Of course we see the physical dangers all around us. The epidemic of knife crime and youth on youth violence casts a haunting shadow over our communities. But I am equally concerned with the psychological warfare unleashed on our children, often through the very system that should have helped protect them. So called 'gender fluidity' is a devilish assault on the minds of young people in attempt to confuse their identity. It's not something I want to make into a hobby horse, but neither is it something that I can ignore.

So what's our response? Build our children on a sure, biblical foundation. Bolster their confidence so that they are not ashamed of what they believe. Also, equip them to skilfully navigate the pitfalls that are being set for them. They need to know how to live within this society, and yet maintain a godly distinction.

There's perhaps no better examples in the Word of God than Daniel and the three Hebrew children. In a strange and hostile environment they managed to rise to the very top, with much sought after skills. But when the enemy thought those skills were for sale they stood resolutely, completely unashamed and unwavering in their faith?

What can parents do? Work with us in partnership. Get your child to Sunday School regularly and on time. Then afterwards ask them what they learned and help reinforce the message.

Stay connected with whatever other initiatives the Church is implementing. Talk with teachers regularly.

Pray for your child everyday in front of them so that they can hear you. Let them hear you call their names before the God of Heaven, so they know you are making the greatest effort to call on the greatest power, motivated by the Greatest Love of All.
